Greetings from Sabari Central School

With great pleasure I would like to inform you that Palakkad Sahodaya has entrusted Sabari Central School, Cherpalcheri to organize & conduct District Chess Championship (Boys & Girls) 2017-18. It is scheduled to be conducted on 15/07/2017 (Saturday) at our school. We cordially invite you to be the champion.

Tournament rules and regulations:

- ▶ Competition is open to four Categories ie; Category I (Classes I to IV), Category II (Classes V to VII), Category III (Classes VIII to X) and Category IV (Classes XI and XII).
- ▶ Separate competitions for both boys and girls.
- ▶ In each section only one candidate can participate.
- ▶ Participating school is required to send Rs. 500 as registration fee and Rs. 150/- per head as the participation fee to the organising school. Money can be remitted directly to the organizing school or to the following Account. The proof of deposit of amount in the A/C No: 15320100052476, IFSC Code: FDRL0001532 in the name of PRINCIPAL CEMCS, Cherpalcheri should be sent to cpcemcs@gmail.com.
- ▶ Eligibility to the concerned categories will be as per PDSSC Rules.

- ▶ All the Principals are requested to submit the list of participants through the online form available in our website www.palakkadsahodaya.weebly.com on or before 05th July 2017.
- ▶ Registration starts at 8.00 AM at the venue on 15th July 2017.

- ▶ Mobile phone and other electronic devices are not allowed in the Hall.
- ▶ Not more than two officials will accompany a school team.
- ▶ Under any circumstances, on the spot entry and late entry will not be entertained.
- ▶ First three individual positions in each category would be awarded with Merit Certificate and for remaining will be awarded participation certificates.
- ▶ No eatables or drinks are allowed in the play area. Tea and lunch are arranged for all the participants by the host school.

System of Play

The championship will be conducted as per FIDE laws of chess under SWISS system. Number of rounds will be decided according to the number of players. (ie; If there are 40 participants, each contestant will have to complete 7 rounds)

Time control

15 minutes plus 5 second increment from move number one. (ie; one match will take a maximum 40 minutes).

Individual Even Tie Break

Direct encounter, Most number of victories (forfeit will be counted), Full Buchholz.

Appeal Committee

In case of any protest or grievances candidate can file a written complaint by paying Rs. 1000 as appeal fee. The decision of the appeal committee will be final.

Requirements during registration

- ❖ All the participants' school must pay at least first instalment fee (renewal fee) of 2017-18 of Sahodaya, otherwise organizing school will not accept any entry.
- ❖ On arrival at organizing school, the team have to report registration desk.
- ❖ All the participants team must have certificate or identity card with students details duly attested by the concerned Head of the Institution while registration.
