Since this is a new fest, all the items suggested by the host school were thoroughly examined and critically discussed before decisions were made.

The decisions taken are as follows:

4 categories as followed by PDSSC for other competitions.

Registration should be done through sahodaya website only. Registration will be open from 6th December onwards. Last date of registration is December 20.

Participation Fees: 300 Rs per participant. Teachers can accompany students at the ratio 1: 10, besides a driver.

Morning and evening snacks and lunch will be provided at the venue.

Category-wise Items and details:

Category 1: (Classes III and IV)

1. Spell Bee: (World of Words)

Individual item. The preliminary will be a written round. Those who are selected will go into the oral round. **(1 hr)**

2. Story Telling:

Individual item. The participant must tell a story using a prop which he/she must bring. **(5mts)**

Costume can be used but will not fetch any extra points.

3. Calligraphy: (Curls and Curves)

Individual item. Paper and matter will be provided. **(15 mts)**

Students must write with a pencil.

4. Role Play:

This is an individual competition. The participant must come with costume and make up and act out the role of a real or imaginary character. *Importance will be given to the speech rather than the acting.* A mike will be provided. **(5 mts)**

Category 2: (Classes V, VI and VII)

1. Poster Making:

This is an individual item. Topics connected to English Language and Literature will be given on the spot. Only paper (A3) will be provided. Participants can use water colour/oil paints/pen/pencil. **(1 hour)**

2. Ad-Mad Show:

Each team will have 2 participants. A product will be given to each team which will have to be advertised in an innovative manner. *A few props will be provided.* **(5 mts)**

3. Western Music:

This is a team event where 7 members can perform as a band. Only English songs are allowed. Use of instruments (played by the participants) is permitted. Uniformity in address is permitted. **(7 mts)**

4. News Reading:

Individual item. News will be provided on a lap top screen. Reading of the news should be as seen on TV. **(3 mts)**

5. Extempore Speech:

Individual item. Topics will be given on the spot. Paper will be provided where points can be jotted down, but reading from it will lead to loss of marks. **(5mts to prepare and 3 mts to speak)**

Category 3: (Classes VIII, IX and X)

1. Poster Making: (as above)

2. Debate:

Individual item. Each school will send in a participant who will participate in an open forum debate on a topic which has been given earlier. **The participant will have to prepare both sides of the argument.** Lots will be taken at the venue to decide whether the speaker will speak 'For' or 'Against' the motion. Each speaker will be given **5 mts to speak** and **1 minute** for rebuttal. Rebuttal means picking up the points of another speaker and refuting them. Personal attacks and unparliamentary language ARE NOT

PERMITTED and will be PENALISED. The best speaker will be selected based on the prepared speech and rebuttal. More weightage will be given to rebuttal. **(5 mts + 1 mt per speaker).**

3. **Declamation:**

Individual item. The participant should deliver a **speech** made by a real or imaginary character. Costumes are not permitted. Controversial speeches or those that might hurt the sentiments of others should NOT be chosen. **(5 mts).**

4. **Translation: Hindi to English**

Individual Item. A given passage will have to be translated paper will be provided. **(30 mts)**

5. **Translation: Malayalam to English**

Individual Item. A given passage will have to be translated, paper will be provided. **(30 mts).**

6. **RJ (Radio Jockey):**

Individual item. The participant must prepare a radio programme (music, requests, health awareness, talk etc) which must be interspersed with advertisements. The topic will be given on the spot and **5 minutes** preparation time will be given and 5 minutes for performance. **(5 mts)**

7. **Quiz on English Language and Literature:**

Team of 2 members. A written round. Selected teams will face a final round. **Questions will be based on English authors, books and films, quotes and proverbs. (2hours)**

General Guidelines

Chest numbers will be available on the Sahodaya website after registration closes. These have to be printed by the schools, photos affixed and attested by the Principal. There will be no kit collection.

Together, let us give a headstart to this new venture by the PDSSC. All the best to all participating schools!
